A selection of more than 40 varieties of plants, all native to New Jersey, will be available at Ihfplants.givesmart.com from 8 a.m., May 15 through 6 p.m., May 21. Pickup will take place at scheduled times on Saturday, May 23 at the Lake Hopatcong Foundation Environmental & Cultural Center, 125 Landing Road, Landing.

Native plants require fewer resources, less maintenance and cost less money while also promoting a healthy ecosystem.
